



November – band meeting and elections

In 2018, the bands 20th year, we will have a fundraiser on February 17th 'Cheers for Twenty Years'. More information will be made available in the near future.

We have a few new band members that need kilt and uniforms, a few more snare drums to replace the used drums purchased almost 20 years ago that we are still using and of course other items (for example reeds, cap badges, drum heads).

We also have a need for new Pipe Chanters as the band grows. Chanter reeds, drum heads and other items need replacing throughout the year. Fundraising is the way the band generates enough to pay for all of these and other things that are needed to run a Pipe Band.

We pay for high level instructors to help teach the band periodically (when financially possible). This is a huge benefit to the band and has improved the overall sound quite a bit over the last 5 or 6 years now.

Over 19 years ago this band was started and performed about 25% of the time for charities. That percentage is close to 75% now as the majority of our performances are for charities. The requests vary from a lone bagpiper to a small group or the entire band performing.

If you wish to have the band, small group or bagpiper perform for just about any event or perhaps perform in your living room or backyard bbq, please let our Band Manager Jim Dougherty (or anyone in the band) know. 





