Irish History #80

Irish History #80 – Manchester Martyrs Redux

April marks the 105th anniversary of the Easter Rising. The 1916 Rising will be commemorated around Easter as it is every year. More will follow in these pages about this milestone event in Irish history. Before turning to the Rising, we look back to the 1867 rebellion and the case of the Manchester (England) Martyrs, which influenced the Rising.

Tom Clarke, known as the “old Fenian,” had the honor of being the first to sign the Proclamation of the Irish Republic read by Padraic Pearse on the Easter Rising’s first day. Although only nine years old in 1867, Clarke remembered that uprising. James Connolly, another who signed the Proclamation, wrote a year before the Rising about the “Fenians of Manchester,” who “struck back at the enemy with blows that are still resounding through the heart of the world.” He said, “[t]he echo of those blows has for a generation been as a baptismal dedication to the soul and life of thousands of Irish men and women, consecrating them to the service of freedom.”

Fenian members of the Irish Republican Brotherhood (IRB) believed their use of armed force to win freedom and independence was justified, because a military struggle against Great Britain was the only way to achieve an Irish Republic. After all, 50,000 British troops and police were stationed in Ireland, when the Fenians plotted to take over rail lines and coast guard stations in 1867. In addition to this daunting challenge, an informer told the British about the plot before it took place. Needless to say, when the uprising occurred it was a spectacular failure.

Public sympathy for the Fenian cause was aroused, however, when three rebels, known as the Manchester Martyrs, were executed by British authorities. Their story began on September 18, 1867 when 30 IRB-men stopped a horse-drawn police wagon, which held prisoners who were on their way from the courthouse to the jail house. IRB leaders, Thomas Kelly and Timothy Deasy, were among the prisoners. They had been arrested for loitering and charged with vagrancy. The IRB’s goal was to free them.

Kelly and Deasy were veterans of the U.S. Civil War. They believed in Irish self-determination, and returned to Ireland after the war. Deasy became commander

of the Fenians in Co. Cork and Kelly became a chief executive in the IRB. British authorities knew both men were active in the IRB.

When the IRB surrounded the police wagon, the mounted police escorting it fled. They left police officer Charles Brett in the locked cage with the prisoners. When Brett ignored commands from the IRB to unlock the door so the prisoners could be freed, one of the IRB raiders fired a shot into the cage-lock to open it. The shot opened the lock and killed Brett. Kelly and Deasy escaped and fled to the United States. They were never re-captured. Kelly ended-up in Atlantic City, where he ran a hotel with his wife; Deasy went to Massachusetts and was later elected to the State House of Representatives.

Brett was the first Manchester police officer killed in the line of duty. His death brought fear, panic and outrage. Ten percent of Manchester’s population was Irish. 30 Irishmen were rounded-up and charged with common purpose and felony murder. The shooter was never identified, and it was unknown if any of the 30 had fired the fatal shot. A motion to change the trial’s venue to London was denied, and 26 defendants went to trial in Manchester. A majority of the 26 were convicted of riot and assault, and sentenced to five-year prison terms.

The jury, which deliberated only an hour and fifteen minutes, rejected the defense claim that the shot was fired just to break the lock, and that no one intended to injure anybody. The jury convicted five defendants - William Allen, Michael Larkin, Michael O’Brien, Thomas Maguire and Edward O’Meagher Condon - of murder. The five were sentenced to death by hanging.

At sentencing, Condon admitted organizing the attack but denied participating. He said he was not there when it happened. He also exclaimed to the court, “I have nothing to regret or retract. I can only say God save Ireland.” When the court announced their death sentences, all of the defendants cried out - “God Save Ireland!” Their cry inspired “God Save Ireland,” a song written a month later. It was the unofficial Irish national anthem until 1916. (It was replaced by the official anthem, “The Soldier’s Song.”) “God Save Ireland” is still a popular Irish rebel-music tune. Now

you can know where it came from when you hear or sing the chorus:

“‘God Save Ireland!’ said the heroes;
 ‘God Save Ireland’ said they all.
 Whether on the scaffold high
 Or the battlefield we die,
 Oh, what matter when for Erin dear we fall.”

Maguire, one of the Manchester IRB defendants and a former Royal Marine, was pardoned. The Crown said Maguire’s pardon was given because witnesses perjured themselves. But those same witnesses had testified against the other defendants who were not pardoned. Condon, an American citizen, also received relief. The U.S. government interceded, and his sentence was commuted to life imprisonment.

Allen, Larkin and O’Brien went to the gallows. (They were the first Irishmen hung since United Irishman Robert Emmet in 1803.) More than eight thousand people witnessed the executions in Manchester on November 23, 1867. One report of the event noted “raucous bacchanalian strains of . . . ‘Rule Britannia’” were sung by the crowd. Irish clergy had instructed their parishioners to avoid the public spectacle and attend mass on the morning of the executions instead. Allen died instantly from a broken neck. Larkin and O’Brien did not. The hangman finished the job on Larkin by pulling on his legs, but O’Brien suffered for 45 minutes before he stopped breathing. The trio were buried in quicklime graves at the prison.

It is not clear why the U.S. Embassy made no effort on O’Brien’s behalf to intervene and stop his execution. O’Brien was born in Cork, but he emigrated to Jersey City and became an American citizen. He fought for the Union during the Civil War with the NJ Light Artillery. He received an honorable discharge when the war ended in 1865. Immediately after the war, he returned to the Emerald Isle and ran guns between Ireland and England. Unlike Condon, O’Brien’s ties to the U.S. did not help him.

The Irish people saw the Manchester trial as a miscarriage of justice, and viewed Allen, Larkin and O’Brien as martyrs. Their courage and sacrifice “electrified nationalist Ireland.” In 1867, even in defeat, the Fenians and IRB pushed Ireland further down the road toward nationhood.
